**NATIONAL NOTICE TO LESSEES AND OPERATORS OF FEDERAL OIL, GAS,
SULPHUR, AND OTHER MINERAL LEASES, OUTER CONTINENTAL SHELF**

**Reimbursement for Providing Meals, Quarters, and Transportation to BSEE
Representatives**

Purpose

This Notice to Lessees and Operators (NTL) provides you with specific instructions for requesting reimbursement when you provide meals, quarters, and transportation to Bureau of Safety and Environmental Enforcement (BSEE) representatives inspecting your lease facilities and operations.

Current regulations authorize you to request and receive such reimbursements in general terms. This NTL clarifies how to request reimbursement.

Authority

Reimbursement of expenses related to inspections of oil, gas, and sulphur facilities and operations are covered under 30 CFR 250.133.

Reimbursement Instructions

You are expected to submit reimbursement requests for any transportation, meals, or quarters provided to an inspector. The BSEE will reimburse you for:

- actual costs incurred for providing transportation for BSEE representatives inspecting lease facilities and operations; and/or
- actual costs incurred as a result of providing meals and quarters during a BSEE representative's stay.

To request reimbursement under 30 CFR 250.133, submit an invoice to the BSEE Office of Offshore Regulatory Programs within 90 days of an inspection of oil, gas, and sulphur operations. Make sure that the invoice identifies the name of the person(s) conducting the inspection; the date(s); what you provided (meal, quarters, and/or transportation); the type of meal(s) provided (specify breakfast, lunch, and/or dinner); and costs for providing meal(s), quarters, and/or transportation. Provide verification of the meals you provided to the BSEE representative, such as a meal log with the inspector's signature.

Guidance Document Statement


