On 3 June 2017 an incident occurred on the Blake 651 rig that resulted in the amputation of 2 fingers on the left hand of a Blake Floorhand. The Blake 651 was conducting abandonment operations for Energy XXI at their South Pass 77C platform.

The night crew began their tour at 1800 hours and continued the operation of laying down 2-7/8" production tubing. At 1935 hours, the crew was laying out their 20th joint of tubing with the injured person (IP) working on the stabbing board. At this time, the IP noticed the cable for the Self Retracting Lifeline (SRL), which was being used by the Floorhand working by the V-Door, was positioned behind one of the fingers in the derrick. This SRL extended approximately 130' from the top of the derrick to the rig floor. While attempting to reposition the cable from the SRL, the IP lost his footing and began to fall forward. In order to stop his forward momentum, the IP extended his left hand out and grabbed the Torque Tube for the Topdrive. At the same time, the Driller was lowering the Topdrive, which made contact with the IP's left hand severing his index and middle fingers.

The BSEE investigators arrived at the location on 6 June 2017 to conduct an investigation. The onsite investigation revealed the following.

- 1) The stabbing board's working surface was described as "slippery".
- 2) The SRL used by the employee working the V-Door was attached in the crown section of the derrick.
- 3) The SRL cable became positioned behind one of the fingers on the monkey board.
