Hazards

The agency's primary concern is minimizing risk to personnel, platform, and the environment.

- Cementing failure
 - Catastropic loss of well control
 - Sustained casing pressure
 - Leaks before and after well abandonment

- Program is structured to follow life of a well
 - Well construction
 - Borehole cleaning
 - Gas migration
 - Cement evaluation
 - Long term integrity
 - Sustained Casing Pressure (SCP)
 - Abandonment

Regulatory Needs

- Industry realities
 - Complexity of cement design
 - "Designer" cement blends
 - Evaluation tools

 Regulatory requirements heavier regarding long term integrity of well

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
