Limitations on Credit Card Collection Transactions and Policy for Splitting Transactions

Effective June 1, 2015, the U.S. Treasury lowered the maximum dollar amount allowed for a credit card collection. The maximum amount that can be charged to a credit card in one day has been lowered from \$49,999.99 to \$24,999.99; this change affects Pay.gov credit card payments. The ACH (electronic check) remittance is to be used for payments greater than \$24,999.99.

Multiple (splitting) transactions in one day may be aggregated and treated as a single transaction. Transactions that result in the aggregate exceeding the maximum daily dollar amount of \$24,999 will be rejected.


