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On June 22, 2014 at approximately 0845 hours, a contract employee (CE) was injured while attempting to depart a stairway from the heliport.

As the CE was attempting to depart a stairway from the heliport, he turned left to access a walkway but failed to realize there was an additional step to make before accessing the next walkway. The CE was carrying a bag that weighed 50lbs. according to the manifest. The CE slipped and landed on his bag as he was attempting to access the walkway injuring his left hip. The CE was examined by a medic onboard the facility and transported to Teche Regional where it was determined he suffered a fractured hip.

The CE has had surgery placing pins in his hip.

The BSEE Lafayette District conducted an onsite investigation to gather additional information on June 24, 2014.
