Injured Person (IP) was flagging the crane while placing parts of another crane on deck. It is our findings that while the operator was walking backward, he was not observant of pinch points. After giving the signal to stop, the load continued to swing. The IP was able to avoid the load, but before he could his head was slightly pinned for a second. IP walked a few feet and collapsed. If he had taken the time to turn sideways while flagging the crane, he would have been aware of any obstacles and pinch points that he came in contact with. The IP was sent in for evaluation by his company doctor. He was placed on restricted duty.
